Guidelines for Applicants to AY 2027 Doctoral Program

- Following the submission of application, applicants will receive a notification regarding their application and the entrance examination via e-mail. Applicants must ensure their e-mail settings allow them to receive messages from both the WEB Application System(application.t[at]ic.t.u-tokyo.ac.jp) and The Graduate School of Engineering Team (daigakuin.t[at].gs.mail.u-tokyo.ac.jp). ※Please replace [at] with @.
- Even for departments whose enrollment capacity is not listed in “6. Examination Subjects and Enrollment Capacity for each Department” for schedule B, admission maybe offered under Application Schedule B (Winter exam). If so, it will be announced on the above webpage around October 1.

Notes for applicants who have foreign nationality

It usually takes about two to three months to obtain a new status of residence following the issuance of the Notification of Admission. Those who need to apply for a Certificate of Eligibility(COE) through this university for enrollment are advised to consider opting for April admission.

Education and Research Goals

The education and research goals at this graduate school are to develop talented individuals who, with a basis in engineering, boldly take up the challenge of exploring unexplored fields and new technological innovations, contribute to the sustainability and development of human society, and who are able to acquire systematic knowledge regarding science and technology as well as an engineering-based thinking, and have the ability to solve social problems with an understanding of diversity and a broad perspective.

Admission Policy

1. Desired student profile

- 1) Strongly motivated to study in accordance with the educational research goals of the Graduate School.
- 2) In addition to advanced expertise in one's major field of study, possesses engineering and logical thinking skills as well as creativity, and has a strong desire to solve social problems.
- 3) Possesses excellent communication skills, foreign language proficiencies, and sound ethics, respects diversity, and aspires to contribute to the international community.

2. Selection Policy

Applicants are selected through written and oral examinations, and submitted documents are evaluated based on the desired student profile. Academic records and foreign language skills are taken into consideration as well. In this selection process, emphasis will be placed on the following.

- High level of expertise in field of interest, and deep engineering-based thinking skills.
- Ability to discover unknown problems and develop creative solutions.
- International communication skills and ability to disseminate research results through those skills.

1. Requirements for Eligibility

This document is a translation from the authoritative Japanese version.

- (1) Those who have obtained, or are expected to obtain by March 31, 2027, a master's or professional degree from a Japanese university. (Note 1) (Note 5)
- (2) Those who have been conferred or are expected to be conferred on or before March 31, 2027, a master's degree by the National Institution for Academic Degrees and Quality Enhancement of Higher Education (NIAD). (Note 5)
- (3) Those who have been conferred or are expected to be conferred on or before March 31, 2027, a degree equivalent to a master's or a professional degree outside of Japan. (Note 2) (Note 5)
- (4) Those who have completed, or are expected to complete by March 31, 2027, a program in an educational institution in Japan that is designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology as providing the program of a foreign graduate school within the education system of a foreign country, and have been conferred or are expected to be conferred a degree equivalent to a master's or a professional degree. (Note 5)
- (5) Those who have completed or expect to complete a program at the United Nations University and have been conferred, or are expected to be conferred by March 31, 2027, a degree equivalent to that of a master's degree. (Note 5)
- (6) Those who have passed or are expected to pass by March 31, 2027, a screening for the fundamental ability for doctorate dissertation research as specified in Article 16-2 of the Standards for Establishment of Graduate Schools at a school outside of Japan, an educational institution mentioned in eligibility (4) above, or the United Nations University, and are recognized by this graduate school as having abilities at least equivalent to those who have a master's degree. (Note 3) (Note 5)
- (7) Those who have graduated from a Japanese university; or have completed at least 16 years of academic education outside of Japan and have been engaged in research at a university, research institute or other institution in Japan or outside of Japan for at least 2 years; or are expected to have been engaged in research for at least 2 years by March 31, 2027; and are recognized by this graduate school as having abilities at least equivalent to those who have a master's degree or a professional degree as a result of said research. - (8) Those 24 years or older as of March 31, 2027, whom this graduate school has recognized, through individual screening of entrance qualifications, as having abilities that are at least equivalent to a master's degree or professional degree holder. (Note 4) (Note 5)

Note 1) Japanese universities mentioned in Eligibilities (1) and (7) above are universities within the boundaries of Japan and as prescribed in Article 83 of the School Education Law.

Note 2) Eligibilities (3) and (7) above include the case of having completed a correspondence program provided by a foreign school of said country while residing in Japan.

Note 3) Those who intend to apply under requirement (6) or (7) above shall submit designated documents for the screening of their entrance qualifications to the Graduate School Team, Graduate School of Engineering Administrative Division (refer to 11. Contact) no later than the dates indicated below, as entrance qualifications are screened individually before submission of application. Please inquire at the Administrative Department of this Graduate School in advance about requirements for application and document submission.

- Note 4) ① Those covered under Eligibility (8) above, are those who are not covered under Eligibilities (1) through (7) above, and those who will be recognized by this graduate school through individual screening of entrance qualification as having abilities at least equivalent to that of a master's degree or a professional degree holder.
- ② Those who intend to apply under requirement (8) above shall submit designated documents for the screening of their entrance qualifications to the Graduate School Team, Graduate School of Engineering Administrative Division (refer to 11. Contact) no later than the dates indicated below, as entrance qualifications are screened individually before submission of application. Please inquire at the Administrative Department of this Graduate School in advance about requirements for application and document submission.
- Application Schedule A: April 21, 2026 (Tuesday)
Application Schedule B: October 27, 2026 (Tuesday)
- ③ Those who are recognized as having abilities at least equivalent to a master's degree or professional degree holder through screening of qualifications will be permitted to apply and to take the entrance examination.

Note 5) Those who wish to enroll on October 1, 2026 shall replace "March 31, 2027" in Eligibilities (1) through (8) with "September 30, 2026".

2. Acceptance of Mature Students

- (1) Mature students are eligible for acceptance in each department. Departments shall accept mature students.
- (2) Persons currently working as full-time employees at companies, educational and research institutes, and other organizations may undertake studies in this doctoral program, concurrent with such employment.
- (3) Selection of applicants shall take into consideration factors including the applicant's master's thesis and related research achievements.

3. How to Apply

The periods for acceptance of applications are divided into two categories - Application Schedule A and Application Schedule B - as indicated below (2).

However, Application Schedule B does not apply to some departments, so please confirm with the department intended for application in advance. Applicants will not be prevented from applying during both acceptance periods, but persons wishing to enter the School in October 2026 shall be subject to the limitations of Application Schedule A.

- (1) Applicants must create an entrance application form via the WEB Application System. All required documents must be converted into PDF format and uploaded to the system. For further details, please follow the instructions provided on the Graduate School's website and the Web Application System. (2) Application period

Application Schedule A: From May 29 (Friday) until 3:00 p.m., June 4 (Thursday), 2026 (JST) **【Strict Deadline】**

Application Schedule B: From November 27 (Friday) until 3:00 p.m., December 3 (Thursday), 2026 (JST) **【Strict Deadline】**

* However, for "Other" in "Documents for Submission," refer to the "Guide to Entrance Examinations" of the department to which the application will be sent, as the submission method or period may differ.

4. Examination Schedule and Venue

(1) Application Schedule A:

The Primary examination will be held over five days, from August 31 (Monday) through September 4 (Friday), 2026. For the examination schedule and venue, refer to the "Guide to Entrance Examinations" of the department to which the application will be sent.

As a general rule, the written examinations of General education subjects (General academic) will be held at specified venues (on the Hongo campus).

The Secondary examinations will be conducted between mid-January and early February, 2027. Details regarding examination dates, timetable and venue will be notified to eligible applicants by around early January 2027. However, for applicants falling under either of the following categories, the secondary examination will be held over five days, from August 31 (Monday) to September 4 (Friday), 2026.

- ① Those who have already obtained a master's degree or professional degree at the time of application, or who are expected to receive a master's degree or professional degree by September 30, 2026. (Note 1)
- ② Those who wish to enroll in October 2026.

Note 1) Secondary examinations will, in some cases, take place sometime between mid-January and early February, even if candidates fall under ①. Please refer to the "Guide to Entrance Examinations" from the department to which application will be sent, or to the notice provided along with the examination admission card.

(2) Application Schedule B:

Primary and secondary examinations will be held between mid-January 2027 and early February 2027. Please refer to the "Guide to Entrance Examinations" of the department to which the application will be sent. Candidates will be advised of examination dates and other relevant information in December 2026, when examination admission card notices will be provided.

5. Selection Methods

(1) Selection shall be based on primary and secondary examinations.

(2) Selection for the primary examination shall be based on a written examination, an oral examination, and submitted documents.

(3) Some departments make selections based on submitted documents. Written examinations, and oral examinations may be conducted only for those who have passed the selections based on their documents. Examination fees will not be refunded even if applicants do not pass the document-based selections. For details, refer to the "Guide to Entrance Examinations" of the department to which the application will be sent.

(4) The secondary examination shall be in regard to the applicant's master's thesis or a related topic. The secondary examination will only be conducted for those who pass the primary examination.

(5) Selection of students for admission shall be based on a comprehensive judgment, taking into account the written examination, the oral examination, submitted documents, the applicant's master's thesis and other related materials.

(These fees are not required for international students on scholarships from the Japanese government (Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology). In addition, no admission fee will be charged to students who are expected to complete a master's or professional degree program in a graduate school at the University of Tokyo.)

1. Admission fee: 282,000 yen (tentative fee)
2. Tuition fees: First term: 260,400 yen (Annual fee: 520,800 yen) (tentative fee)

(Note) The amounts indicated above are tentative. If amounts are amended at the time of admission or while the individual is registered as a student, the new amounts shall apply from the time of the amendment in question.

9. Precautionary Notes

- (1) Applicants cannot apply to two or more departments or programs within the Graduate School of Engineering at the same time. Those who have passed the primary examination of the Application Schedule A of the school cannot apply for Schedule B unless they withdraw from Schedule A. In addition, applicants cannot be enrolled in other universities or other schools within The University of Tokyo concurrently with their enrollment in the Graduate School of Engineering.
- (2) Applications will not be accepted unless all the required documents are complete and submitted by the application deadline. After the application process is complete, no changes to documents will be accepted and no documents will be returned, under any circumstances.
- (3) Applicants must print out their examination admission card from the Web Application System: My Page and bring it on the day of the examination. The examination admission card will be available from:

Application Schedule A: Around 3p.m., Friday, July 3 , 2026

Application Schedule B: Around 3p.m., Tuesday, December 22 , 2026

- (4) Those who wish to enroll while remaining in their current employment status must submit at the time of admission procedures, a Letter of Approval from their employer (in any format; the specific title of the person providing approval does not matter as long as they hold a higher position), certifying that there is no interference with their enrollment while remaining employed.
- (5) In the School of Engineering, some departments allow admission in October 2026 in addition to April 2027. For more details, refer to the “Guide to Entrance Examinations” of the department to which the application will be sent.
- (6) The University of Tokyo provides reasonable accommodations to ensure that individuals with disabilities, etc. are not disadvantaged during entrance examinations and studies after enrollment, and provides consultations for this purpose. Those who wish to request accommodations for entrance examinations and studies after enrollment should contact the office of the department where they are applying before application deadline (refer to 4. How to Apply). Although requests made after the above deadline will still be considered, it is recommended that applicants send their requests well in advance as it may not be possible to provide certain accommodations without sufficient preparation time. - (7) Applicants who have foreign nationality must have a visa that will allow admission to a Japanese graduate school, as stipulated in the “Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act (Law No. 319, 1951),” by the time of admission procedures.
- (8) Under some circumstances, application procedures, examination dates and way of conducting, and other details may be subject to change.
- (9) Once paid, examination fees will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- (10) After the admission process is completed, admission fees will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- (11) The University of Tokyo shall use the personal information obtained through the application process only for the purpose of ① Selection procedures, ② Notification of results and ③ Enrollment procedures. For those who enroll, this personal information and the examination results used for admission selection shall also be used for ④ Educational Affairs (school registration, attendance, etc.), ⑤ Student Support (healthcare, career support, application procedure for tuition exemption and scholarships, use of libraries, etc.) and ⑥ the Management of tuition payment.
- (12) The examination results used for admission selection may be used in future studies for the improvement of admission and education systems at the University of Tokyo.
- (13) In case of an unexpected situation such as a natural disaster, please note that information related to entrance examinations will be offered on the Graduate School of Engineering website.

10. Response to fraud

If any false statement or forgery is found in the application documents, or if clear evidence of any fraudulent activity during the examination is found, admission and enrollment may be canceled even after the applicant has been accepted or has already entered this Graduate School.

Official TOEFL iBT or TOEFL iBT Home Edition scores must be submitted as specified below.

[About TOEFL scores]

- The Graduate School of Engineering accepts “Test Date Scores” only. “MyBest scores” are not accepted.
- Applicants should check the ETS website for information on how to apply, required equipment and examination environment of the TOEFL iBT Home Edition on their own.
- Applicants cannot submit score sheets from group testing systems such as TOEFL ITP.
- TOEFL ITP will not be conducted on the day of Graduate School of Engineering entrance examination.
- Applicants should submit TOEFL scores even if their native language is English.

[How to submit TOEFL scores]

Please complete all three procedures listed below (①, ② and ③) for the submission of your scores.

① Obtain a TOEFL iBT score and send your official TOEFL scores

When registering for a TOEFL test, be sure to request ETS to transmit your scores according to “Send TOEFL Institutional Score Report to” below through your ETS account, by the deadline of the department you wish to apply for. If you did not request ETS to transmit your scores at the time of registration, please do so as soon as possible. If you have successfully requested the official TOEFL scores transmission and there is no problem during your TOEFL test, we typically receive your score report data online about 5 days (from Jan.21,2026 onward) after you take the test. The scores will be considered officially received only when its data is verifiable by this graduate school.

- You may send your scores multiple times. However, we will only accept the score report that corresponds to the Appointment Number and the test date registered on the WEB Application System.

③ Upload your Test Taker Score Report to the WEB Application System (My Page).

Upload your Test Taker Score Report (PDF) that corresponds to the Appointment Number and test date you registered on the WEB Application System by the deadline set by the department you wish to apply for. You will be able to download your Test Taker Score Report (PDF) from your ETS account starting around 72 hours (from Jan.21,2026 onward) after your test date.

- The Appointment Number, Test Date and Test Taker Score Report can be modified on the Web Application System as many times as necessary, as long as it is within the score submission deadline of the department you wish to apply for.
